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The Disability Policy Lens (2nd ed.)

In recent months, with the assistance of colleagues in the federal government, we have revised the <u>Disability Policy Lens</u> to make it more useful to policymakers, advocates, students and researchers. The 2nd ed. is now available on the CDPA website. The Lens is a tool for analysing disability policy, consisting of 7 questions that probe the critical details and implications of policy for people with disabilities.

The Lens is advantageous, in that it is:

- Analytical vs. evaluative it does not try to distill the complexity of disability policy analysis into a score or summary, but rather elaborates the many possible implications of policy for the lives of people with disabilities;
- Brief one page, 7 questions;
- Versatile applicable to all types of policy.
