

Accessible meetings

Fully accessible meetings are a micro-level expression of the CDPA's vision of inclusion for people with disabilities. They are also a feature of our commitment to involving all of our partners in all aspects of the Alliance's work. To that end, we allocated approximately 10% of our annual budget to bringing partners together semi-annually to review progress, monitor accountability and make plans. Thanks to Mike Schaub, the original Project Coordinator for the CDPA, we developed a detailed protocol for organizing and conducting fully accessible meetings, learning from our consumer partners about physical, visual and auditory accessibility.
