Among several ways we achieved this was providing personnel support to students working in the area of disability policy. Between 2009 & 2014, the CDPA provided 10 scholarships to graduate students studying disability-related topics across the country. We supported 4 Masters students and 6 Doctoral students, studying topics as diverse as assistive technology, philosophical conceptualizations of disability, inclusive education, disability savings plan.
