



Government offices responsible for disability supports and services

Locating and navigating government disability services is often described as difficult and frustrating. In some ways, there is little wonder that it is, since disability is such a complex issue, and disability services span different levels of government (federal & provincial), as well as different ministries or departments within government. We have attempted to identify the “office most responsible” for disability issues in each jurisdiction in Canada, to at least provide a starting place for inquiries about disability policy, supports, services and information.
